<a10> what about rolling admissions like CBS?

<helpmehelpme> stern columbia MIT :) harvard too prolly. stanford

<JonAdmissionado> Mehta: An MS is great, but its still not work experience, not unless you are working simultaneously... for a PhD, maybe you could make that argument

<Debayan> JonAdmissionado, how much does it make sense to do an MBA in US with short and long term goals of working in Asia (India or other south Asian countries)
