Contribution, collaboration, and community

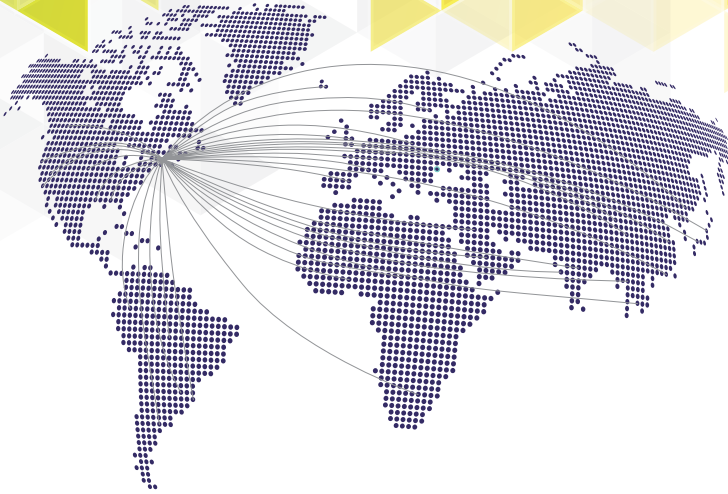
