21:53	Aringo_Prasanth	As you know there are more consultants out there than we probably need 🤖 and many have different opinions. So use your own judgment with these advice 😊
21:53	Aringo_Prasanth	1- A good essay will attempt to do several things - it will capture the attention of the reader from the get go. It will have a compelling narrative, story arc that keeps things interesting till the end. It will above all, address the question carefully and showcase applicant's strengths and differentiate him/her from the crowd. A bad essay on the other hand, will be boring to read and won't have a strong story to support the narrative
21:54	madhan	Sure my GMAT is 750+.To offset poor undergrad grades would a high masters GPA from a top international engineering university be OK?? Do u recommend providing alternative transcripts for H/S/W.
