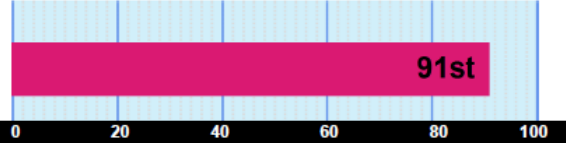

Definition

SUMMARY - VERBAL

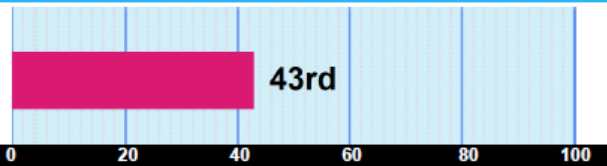
- Your Verbal score of 40 is higher than 91% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this section is 27.04.

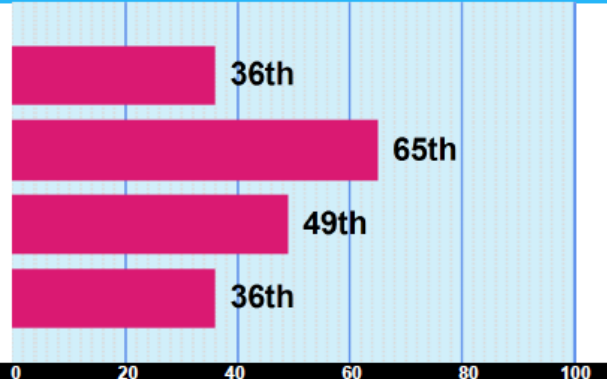

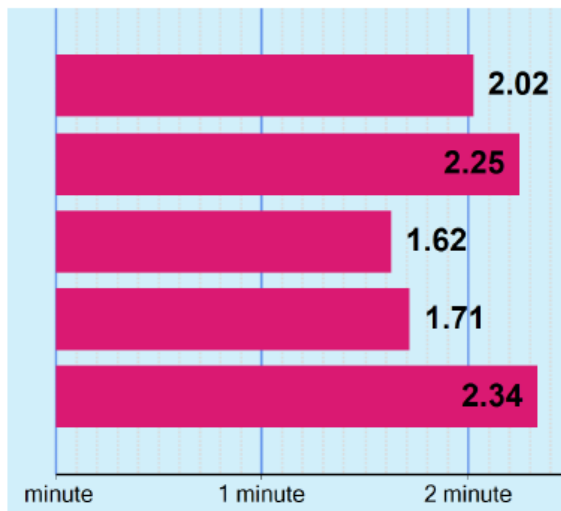
