22:31	Narenn	Previously, both of them have worked in INSEAD's admissions team. Caroline was director of Admissions at INSEAD and Melissa was assistant director.
22:32	CarolineFortuna	Hello everyone! Thanks for the intro Narenn
22:32	Narenn	Welcome Caroline and Melissa! Thanks for joining! This is the first time we are hosting chat with Fortuna Admissions. Pleasure to have you here.
22:32	Narenn	Dear Participants: Today Caroline and Melissa will answer your questions regarding applications, essays, interviews, and life at INSEAD.
22:32	CarolineFortuna	Delighted to join!
22:32	Narenn	There are around 30 chat participants and more are expected to join in couple of minutes, so it is humble request to all participants to adhere to the following rules during chat.
22:32	Narenn	1) Ask the questions one by one. Before posting your question, make sure earlier question is answered.
22:32	Narenn	2) Do not ask profile specific questions e.g. What are my chances etc.
22:32	Narenn	3) Keep the question typed in advance and paste them in chat box when earlier question is answered.
22:32	Narenn	Before we begin the session, I would request Caroline and Melissa to give us short introduction of you and your company, Fortuna Admissions
22:34	CK8	Greetings Caroline!

22:34	CarolineFortuna	Hi everyone - I was Director of Admissions at INSEAD 2005-2012; Melissa was a senior member of my team. We now work together at Fortuna Admissions, a team of ex Directors of Admissions and senior staff from top business schools inc INSEAD, Wharton, HBS, Stanford, etc.
22:35	CarolineFortuna	Fortuna Admissions advises candidates applying to top b schools and coaches them through the admissions process.
22:32	Guest35810	Nowhere it's available the acceptance rate or interview rate for insead mba.. can you throw some light on that? & difference between jan and spe intake is surely about internship.. but can you highlight the competitiveness of jan intake as most of the crowd buys usa mba or say sep intake. is there any advantage?
22:33	CarolineFortuna	@Guest358: there is no difference in the level of competition Jan v Sept. In fact the school gets slightly more apps for Sept start but slightly lower yield (percentage accepting the offer) so the offer rate is the same.
22:37	CarolineFortuna	The school does not publish details of the admissions pool; most of the weeding out is done at the preselection for interview stage; at interview stage you can expect an approx 50% chance of admission.
22:35	CK8	How important is diversity in the class profile?
22:35	MelissaJones	@CK8 diversity is very important for INSEAD as there isn't one nationality that takes up more than 10% of the class. That is if you are talking about nationality! Diversity also includes prof background etc as they want a mix of people from different work backgrounds
22:36	tdhamit	For LOR's, would you suggest to keep both the recommendations from professional group (I have been working with Microsoft for last 4.5 years) or is it better to diversify with one professional and one volunteer group (Toastmasters for e.g.). Thanks.
22:36	CarolineFortuna	@tdhamit: the school prefers professional recommendations rather than from e.g. volunteer roles
22:36	Jonas84	In the job description essays we are told to provide a short answer. How long can an essay be? I mean "give a full description of your career since graduating from university. Describe your career path with the rationale behind your choices. (short answer) "how short can this really be? The shortest I was able to make it was 800 characters.

22:39	MelissaJones	@Jonas84 We suggest about 300 words for the job description + another 300 words for your career evolution essay. If you go over that it's totally fine but just try and keep it close to 300
22:37	Amit	Does INSEAD look favorably at candidates with 10+yrs experience and age being 35 ? Is this an advantage or disadvantage - other parameters like GMAT/Extra-curriculars remaining competitive.
22:37	CarolineFortuna	@Amit: the age range on the programme is typically 23 to 35 with the average age in the upper 20s. Candidates in the mid 30s may be seen as a better fit for the Executive MBA and may be pointed in that direction instead.
22:38	Purva_D	Hi.. I would like to know the details regarding scholarships provided
22:41	CarolineFortuna	@Purva: the school has a range of scholarships available; the criteria generally include a mix of merit and financial need. Full descriptions of the scholarships are on the school website. see http://mba.insead.edu/financing/
22:38	busmen	What is the importance of the last optional essay question (anything you would like to tell us), what is the advised topic for that question, and how important is the optional recommendation letter?
22:41	MelissaJones	@busmen. If you didn't get a chance to speak to something in your application, then the optional essay is a great place for this. For example you have a side project/side company that you are running or are starting up. Or if your gmat is low you could use this section to validate your quant/verbal skills through work, other courses you've taken etc. But don't use this optional essay unless you have something to add. No repetition. It's totally fine to not use this essay at all.
22:38	groovify	Hi Caroline - Is it completely futile applying to INSEAD without significant international experience? To what extent can the uniqueness of a profile offset the lack of international experience?
22:41	CarolineFortuna	@groovify: it is tough to get in without any international experience at all. How much international experience do you have?
22:38	mib_ri8ypq	Could you please speak frankly about the chances of a non-US, non-EU citizen to find a job in the US post INSEAD?
22:43	CarolineFortuna	@mib_ri8: US visas can be a challenge; if you are purely focused on working in the US then you may be better off applying to a US MBA program which gives you the right to stay in the country

		for 12 months post MBA. It depends also on how attractive your profile is to potential recruiters.
22:44	mib_ri8ypq	Thank you! What about positions in Western Europe (UK in particular) for a non-UK non-EU citizen?
22:48	CarolineFortuna	@mib_ri8: easier than the US. UK has a points based system and how easy or difficult it is to get a visa depends on your individual profile. But generally if you have a strong profile, a clear career goal and a profile that is attractive to your target recruiters, you should be fine.
22:38	CK8	Apart from nationality.... Business School for the World.... there are other parameters for diversity such as age/ experience
22:42	MelissaJones	@CK8 yes you are correct. So diversity in terms of nationality, sex, age, prof background etc
22:41	Amit	Thanks Caroline, but is it impossible to get in with this age criteria?
22:43	CarolineFortuna	@Amit: how old would you be at the start of the programme?
22:44	Amit	36 with 10.5 yrs exp in banking industry with Standard Chartered and HSBC
22:45	CK8	Incidentally Amit my experience/ profile is similar to yours!
22:56	CarolineFortuna	@Amit: I think your chances will be very slim unfortunately. Very rare that the school takes a candidate over 35 for the full time programme. If they like your profile they will point you to EMBA
22:42	indruze	Hi, I've noticed there's not a single question in the application asking "Why Insead"? I presume this is done on purpose? I couldn't find where to place the information that I had visited campuses, attended open days, talked with the alumni. So is it a test of an applicant's creativity of where to put it, or does Insead deliberately not ask it?
22:44	MelissaJones	@indruze Good question. There use to be a question about this but they took it out. So yes it was done on purpose. No need to include this in other parts of the essays. They were finding the essay wasn't adding much as people said similar things. you can talk about why INSEAD if you get to the interview phase - the interviewers will no doubt ask you about that
22:42	Guest35810	job prospects between France and Singapore campus? Especially for finance? and also how much INSEAD is famous for finance roles post mba? And do they care of 8 months spent outside home country for work as compared 3 years worked outside?

22:45	CarolineFortuna	@Guest358: job prospects are the same across campuses. Recruiters cannot recruit at the school unless they recruit on both campuses; however, obviously your local networking opportunities are different, so you should think about where you want to be geographically. Finance recruitment is strong. 3 years is likely to carry more weight in terms of international.
22:42	ps3012	Wait list candidates are usually recommended to inform Adcom about major updates such as promotions. However, the timing and occurrence of such things is not under direct control of an individual. What are some other things that applicants can do to show an enhanced profile to Adcom (besides GMAT)?
22:47	MelissaJones	@ps3012 For waitlisted candidates, you could mention any new responsibilities you have taken on at work if a promotion hasn't happened. Or a new project you asked to be put on? Also perhaps you have engaged in other extra curriculums if this was an area lacking in your app. Does that help?
22:43	CK8	Is it possible to share a successful essay... to get idea of tone/ style of writing....
22:43	groovify	@caroline - Professionally, I have had a total of 3 months of business travel to 5 countries. Personally, I am heavily into international backpacking travel and music festival tourism.
22:44	groovify	@caroline - but I don't have great achievement bullets to show for those 3 months of business travel.
22:46	CarolineFortuna	@groovify: it sounds like you may have a minimum of international experience and exposure that makes you eligible to apply, however you'll need to shine in other parts of your app as other candidates will have more international exp than you
22:50	CarolineFortuna	@groovify: you don't have to have a huge number of professional accomplishments to point to during your time abroad, but you do need to show that you learned something interesting and valuable from the experiences, and that you have a perspective that will be a useful addition to the classroom
22:46	Narenn	Newly Joined Members: We are chatting with Caroline Diarte Edwards and Melissa Jones, former INSEAD admission directors and presently admission consultants at Fortuna Admissions, an admission consulting company run by former Bschoo Adcoms.

They are just looking at who will make up the best class, regardless of salary. Just show your experience as an entrepreneur and passion for it post MBA + show your passion as to how INSEAD is such an entrepreneurial driven school (throughout your essays)
22:49	busmen	For the essay questions, how do recommend for the weight between professional and personal, I guess 100% professional is not a good idea
22:51	CarolineFortuna	@busmen: it depends on the question. The "candid description" essay can be more personal (and sometimes candidates miss an opportunity in this essay to tell more of their personal story). Otherwise the essays should mainly be professionally focused except the extra curriculums essay.
22:49	ps3012	What is the appropriate level of communication for wait list students with INSEAD adcom?
22:53	CarolineFortuna	@ps3012: it is good to stay in touch with your Admissions Officer, to show that you are committed and ready to step in. I would suggest about once per month - send a friendly check in, or call; or get in touch of course when you have an important update about your profile to share
22:49	groovify	@caroline - thanks. How additionally important is it to explain how one would use the internship period in a January intake application, compared to the September application?
22:53	CarolineFortuna	@groovify: you don't need to address this unless it is an important part of your story about your career goals and how you are going to get there
22:50	CK8	I have lots of achievements across work and extra curr. activities, so does it help to show a well rounded personality or is it better to focus. Could one potentially carry a portfolio of work to the interview
22:53	MelissaJones	@CK8 Yes how a well rounded profile - work achievements, leadership examples, your post MBA plans (short term and long term goals should be very clear) your personality -

		strenthgs/weaknesses, int'l exposure, experience and hobbies/extra cv's
22:50	mib_bilal	Hello sir. I want to ask how Insead considers applicants with prior MBA degree...
22:55	CarolineFortuna	@mib_bilal: having a previous MBA is definitely a negative. It doesn't rule you out completely, but will count against you to a certain extent.

22:56	ps3012	Ok, thanks. I had sent a progress update about 5-6 days back and haven't heard back since then from my admissions officer. I do not want to pester with a call but I am getting a little anxious with the wait and no response. Should I continue waiting for a response?
22:58	CarolineFortuna	@ps3012: I would wait and then call in a week.
22:56	Rahil	how does INSEAD perceive people who come from a NON-entrepreneurial background but aim to start their own venture post MBA?
22:58	MelissaJones	@Rahil - As I said INSEAD is a very entrepreneurial school and they welcome people with ent. backgrounds - of course speak to your achievement within your ent endeavors and why exactly do you need an MBA to start your own venture. A lot of candidates post MBA plans are to start their own companies so they def view it favorably.
22:57	vmundhra	Does INSEAD entertain Re-Applicant? Some where I read they don't encourage.
23:00	CarolineFortuna	@vmundhra: Indeed the communication from the school is not very encouraging (different to US schools) but in reality the school does get a fair number of reapplications and they can get admitted if there is a change in the profile (positive change). Otherwise if there is no change in the profile, almost certainly the decision will be the same

22:59	mib_ri8ypq	Can you please also comment on the chances to enter top strategy consulting (MBB) with no previous experience in the private sector prior to INSEAD? For example, someone who was in the public/non-profit sector before
23:03	CarolineFortuna	@mib_ri8: it is certainly feasible. MBB is actually quite open to a range of backgrounds. I remember a student at INSEAD who was a professional pianist and joined McK post MBA. Funnily enough, we recently had a client who went to another school and made exactly the same switch from being pianist. They are looking for smarts and potential.
22:59	busmen	Does INSEAD favor risk takers or more balanced type?
22:59	DS	Caroline I work for a small to medium enterprise, it's an Organization and Leadership consulting firm. Do you think I can use optional Essay in Motivation essay to explain the nature of the work that the company does and how I have benefited by it?
23:04	CarolineFortuna	@DS: might be better to put that in your job description short answer essay?
22:59	CK8	While I agree that age is part of typical profile.... different age grps add to diversity
22:59	MelissaJones	@CK8 yes age too does add to diversity. INSEAD's classrooms are mixed from ages 24/25 up to 35 ish.
23:00	CK8	How long should a good interview last, what are the indicators that your interview is successful
23:06	MelissaJones	@CK8 interviews can be from 30 minutes to 3 hours! I've heard it all. Generally they last an hour. I'm sure you'll have a good sense if it is going well - if you've answered the questions well and were well prepared. Just make sure you ask them lots of questions too as people like to talk about themselves! You can always ask at the end of the interview as to
23:07	MelissaJones	@CK8 as to how they thought it went and if they see any weaknesses in your profile. Then if they mention something you can take a moment to speak to that point and get them to change their view!
23:07	CK8	wow! thanks! Your guidance is most clear
23:00	mib_lp24br	How does the school see a candidate applying at around 32-33? I know you mentioned above 35+ the chances are slim. But wanted to know around 32+.

23:02	groovify	@caroline - By the 35 age limit, do you mean 35 at the time of round 1 application, or 35 at the time of matriculation?
23:06	CarolineFortuna	@groovify: the school always looks at age in terms of how old you would be at the programme start (that is the data they use in the class statistics)
23:03	busmen	Generally speaking, does INSEAD favour risk takers or more balanced type?
23:04	CarolineFortuna	@busmen: no particular preference - they are looking for a diverse class
23:05	busmen	Is the optional recommendation letter also important or only marginal?
23:07	CarolineFortuna	@busmen: really not necessary to submit an optional reco letter and better not to do so unless it really adds something very important. The app is already long and you don't want to annoy the file reader with too much to wade through 😊
23:05	vmundhra	Does an additional recommendation from recent alumni help to get additional value?
23:08	CarolineFortuna	@vmundhra: possibly, if they know you very well.

23:12	MelissaJones	@Ck8 - there have been 39 year olds in the program before but perhaps their EMBA is better suited for you? Have you looked into it?

23:11	CarolineFortuna	@vmundhra: you need to show a strong fit with the program; that you have progressed well in your career (sometimes candidates in their 30s look like they have reached a plateau); also important to have a clear career plan.
23:10	busmen	How long does the officer take to go through an application, say on average?
23:12	CarolineFortuna	@busmen: It depends but I would say that on average, about 30-45 mins is spent on reviewing and discussing a file at the interview selection stage, and then typically a bit more than that at the final admissions committee stage.
23:11	CK8	Although I am on the other side of the age profile, I am decided for INSEAD
23:12	DS	Caroline how strict is INSEAD with the word limit for Motivation essays?
23:14	CarolineFortuna	@DS: if you are about 5% or a bit more over, that is OK. I would be careful about going 10% or more over esp if the content is not really essential
23:12	busmen	Talking about resume, I guess we should stick to 1 page? Do they favour INSEAD format? or the format really does not matter
23:16	CarolineFortuna	@ busmen: regarding the resume, better to stick to one page if you can, but not required/essential. The INSEAD format is purely optional so if you find it tricky at all I would suggest using a more standard format. No issue.

23:17	MelissaJones	@vmundrha Both Jan and SEpt entries are equally competitive. Almost the same number of applicants

23:19	MelissaJones	@CK8 Your interviewers are only given your CV or the first 10 pages of your application. However don't assume they will read any of it. It's up to you to cover all aspects of your profile - so cover your prof experience, accomplishment, hobbies, etc plus mention in'tl experience/exposure. Cover it all!
