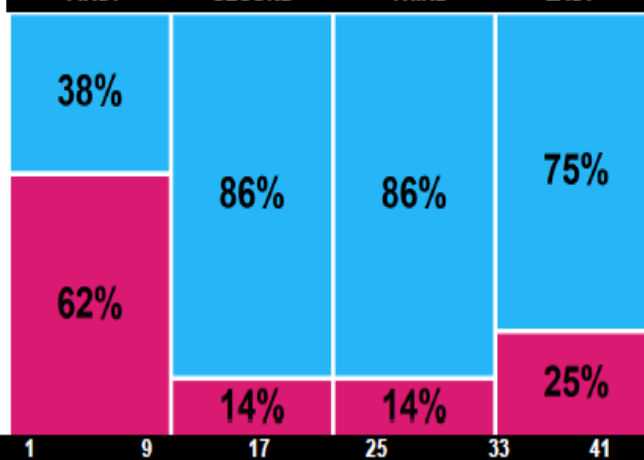

Definition

For all GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years the mean time to complete a question in the Verbal section is 1:42 minutes.

☐ Your Verbal score of 21 is higher than 26% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this section is 27.04.

☐ Your performance on Critical Reasoning questions was equivalent to a score of 19, which is better than 22% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this sub-section is 27.61.

☐ Your performance on Reading Comprehension questions was equivalent to a score of 21, which is better than 29% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this sub-section is 27.32.

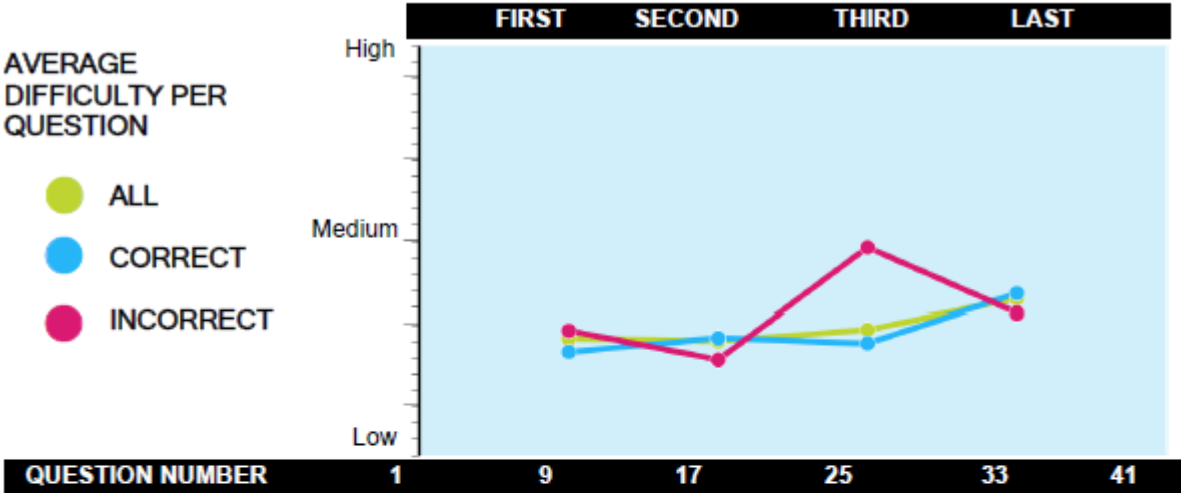
