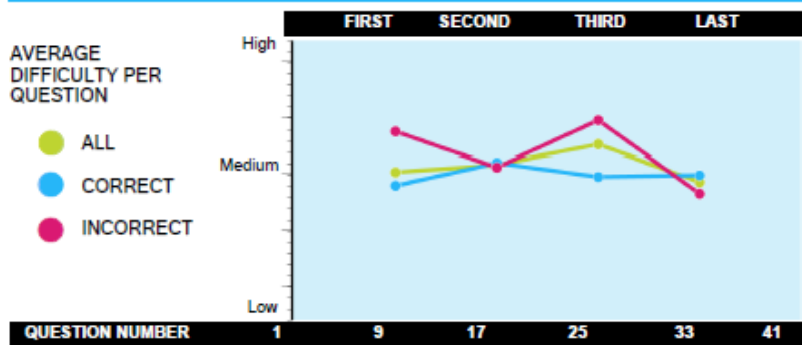

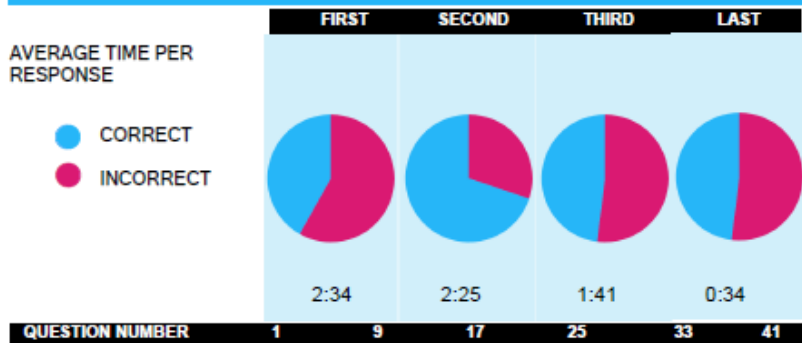

SUMMARY
