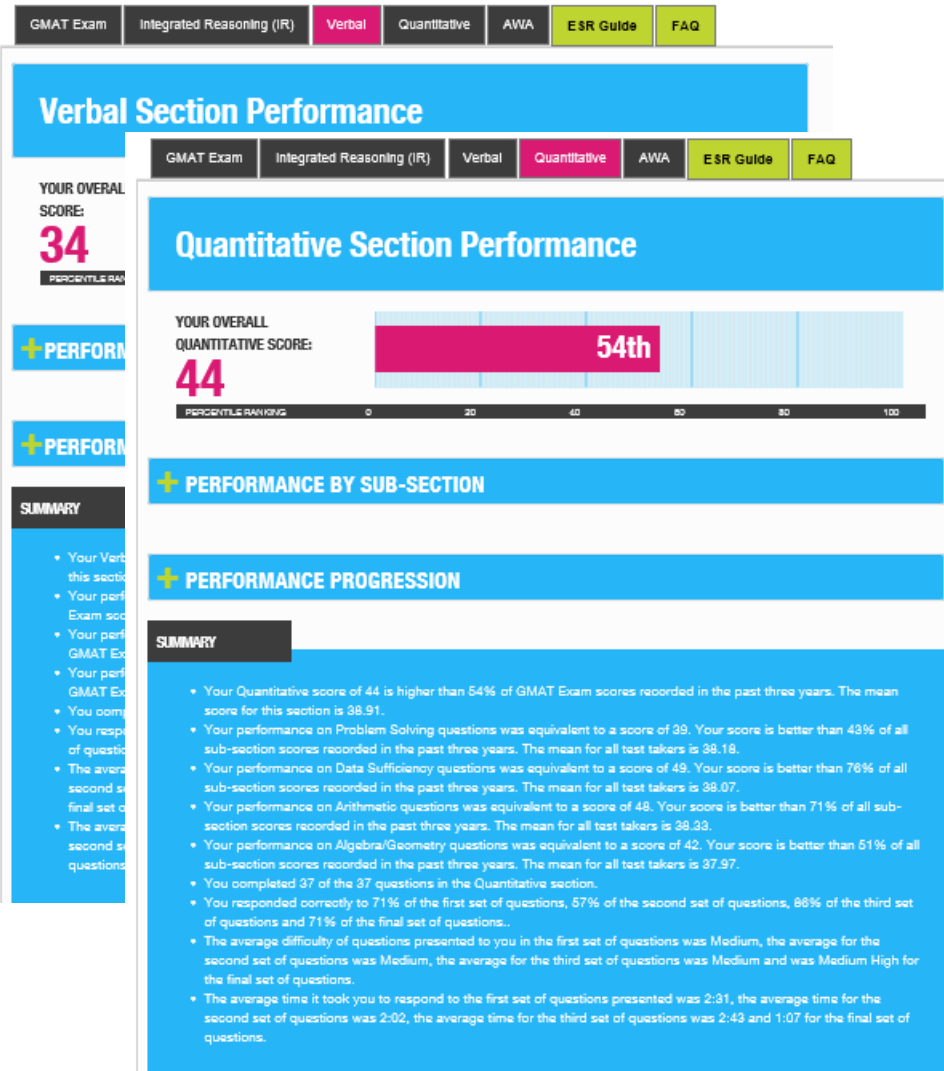

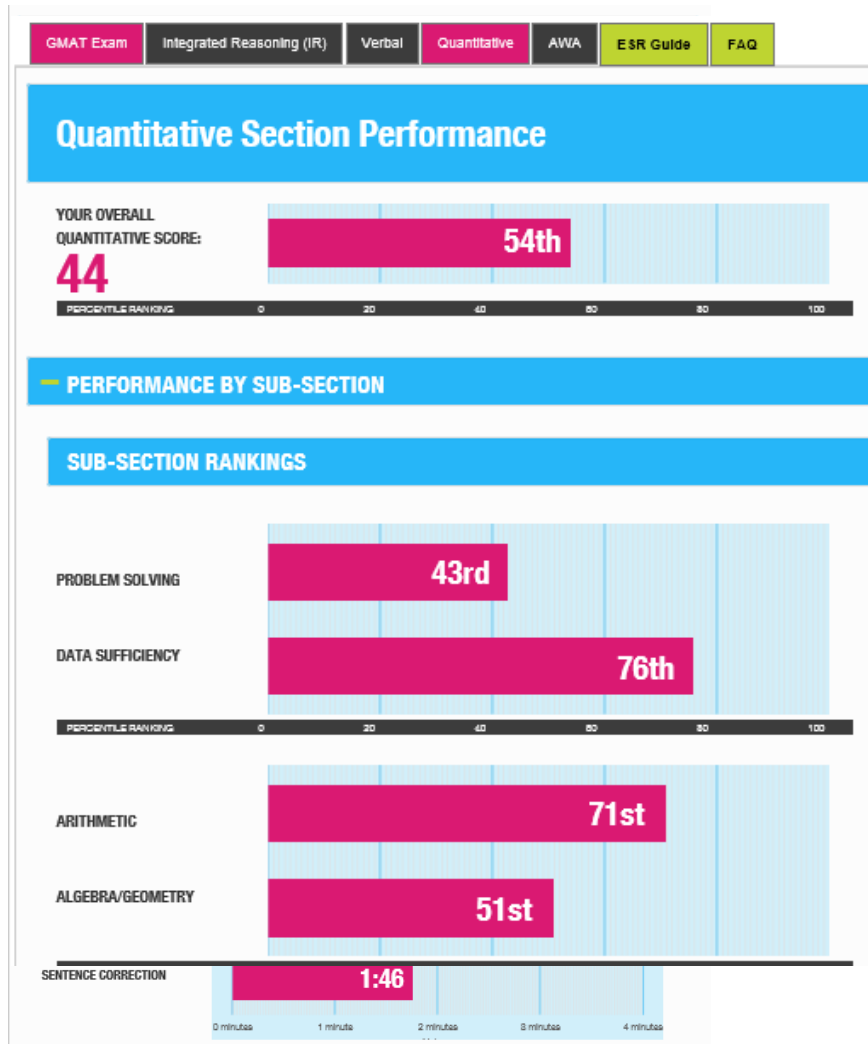

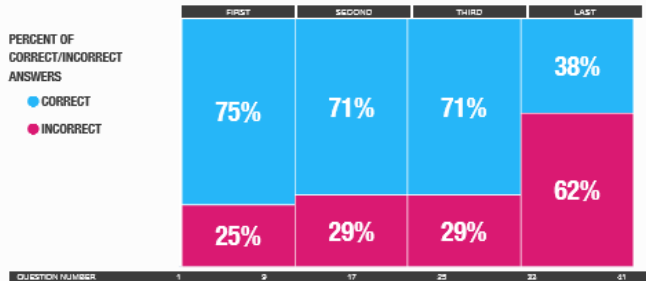

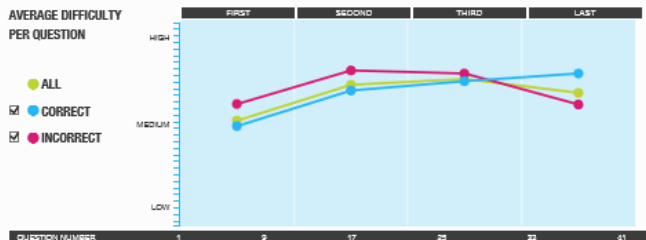

PERFORMANCE PROGRESSION

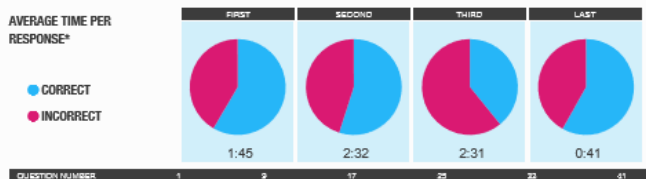
PERCENT CORRECT

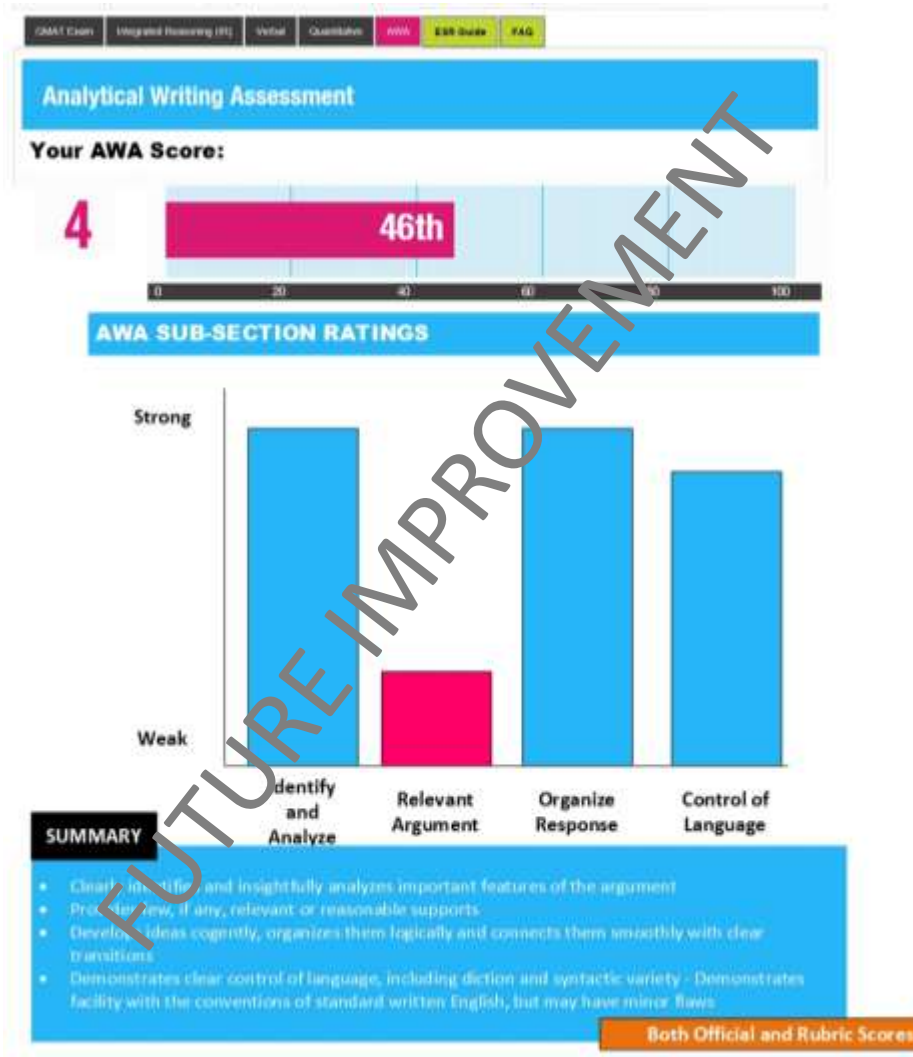


Performance Progression

- Average Time (Correct vs. Incorrect)

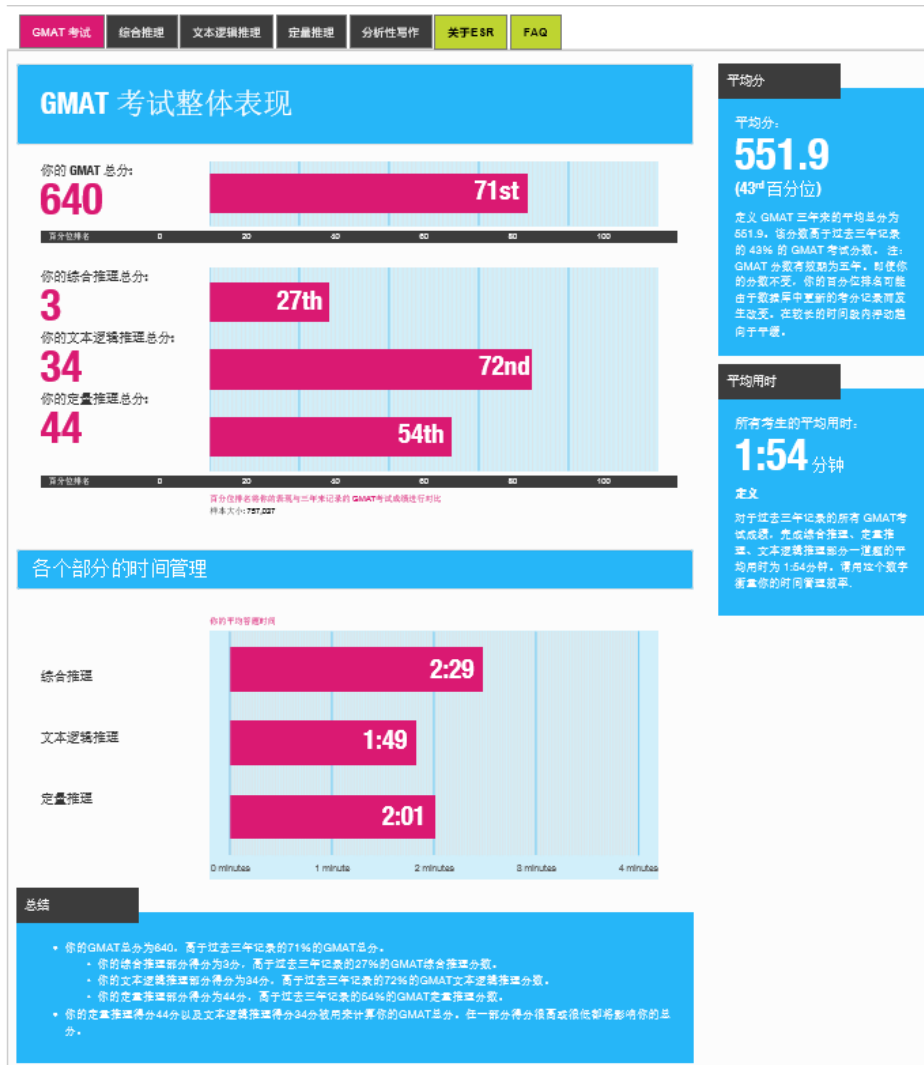
