

Note: The concept of subject-verb agreement does *not* apply to *future tense*. Sentences in *future tense* always take the *plural* form. For example:

The boy will play in the park.

The boys will play in the park.

Notice that whether the subject in *singular* (boy) or *plural* (boys), the *plural* form of the verb (*play*) is used, since both the above sentences are in *future tense*.

Similarly, the concept of subject-verb agreement does *not* apply to *simple past tense*. For example:

The boy played in the park.

The boys played in the park.
