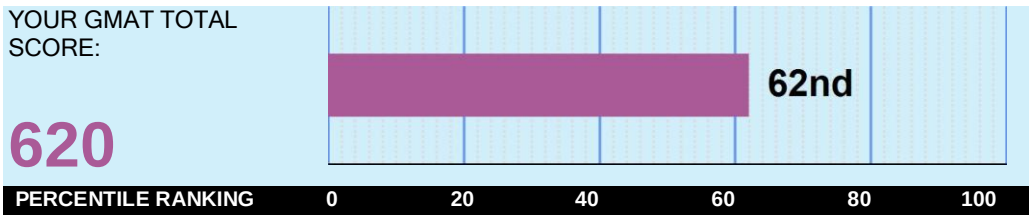

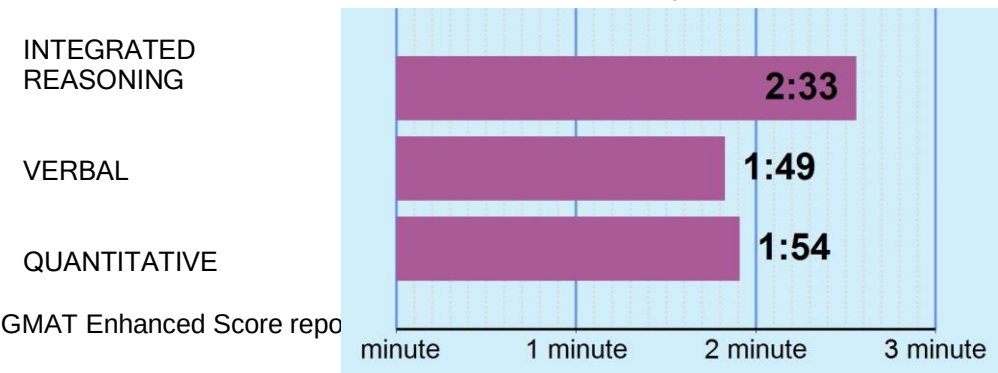

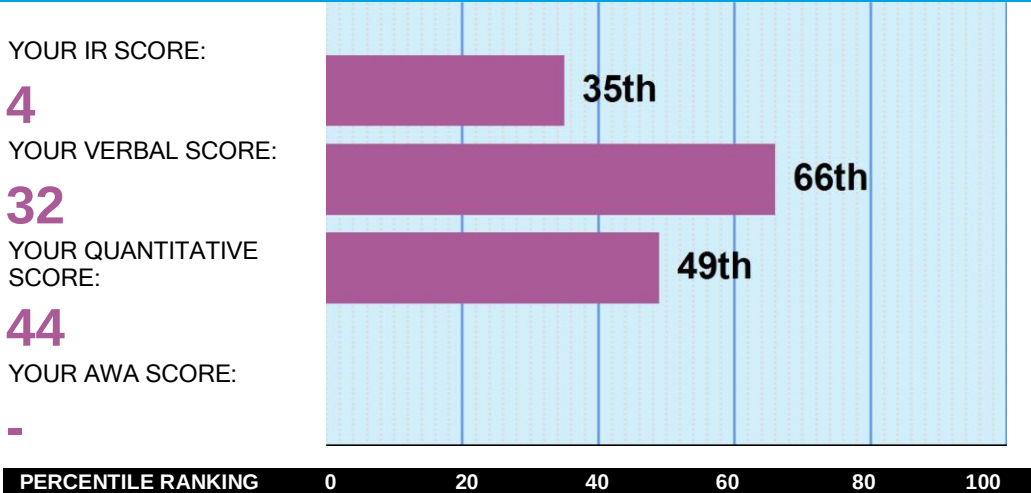
YOUR MEAN RESPONSE TIME PER QUESTION

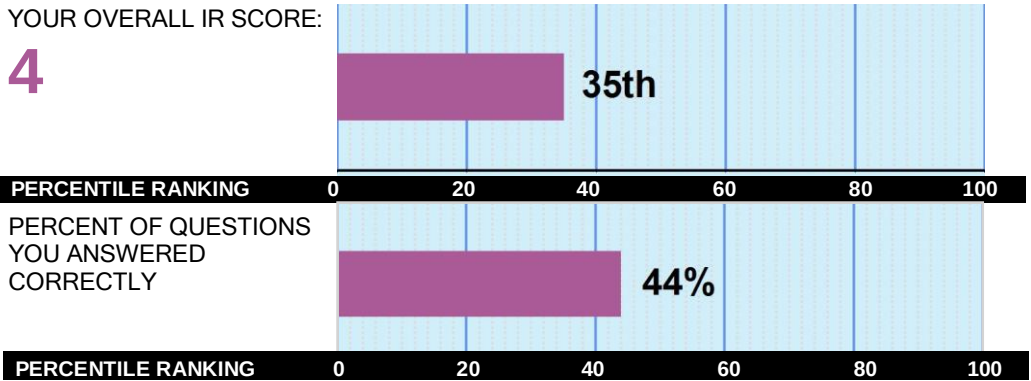

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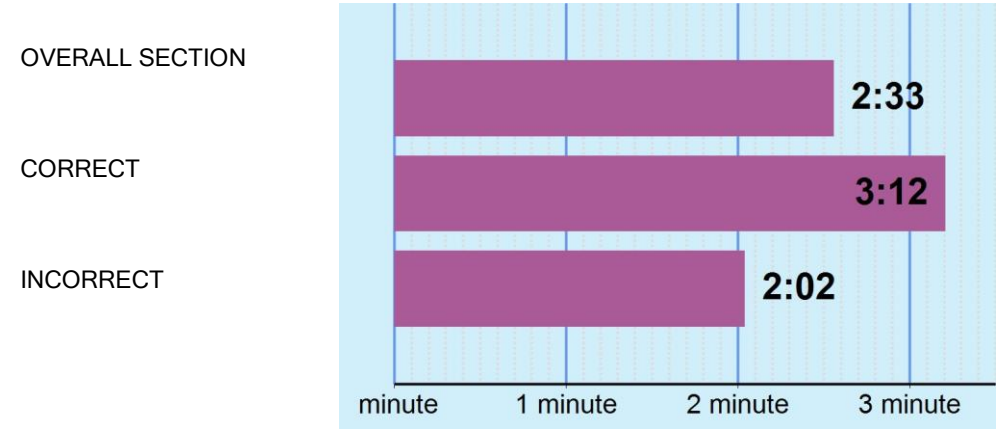
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PERCENTILE RANKINGS COMPARE YOUR PERFORMANCE TO 3 YEARS OF GMAT EXAMS

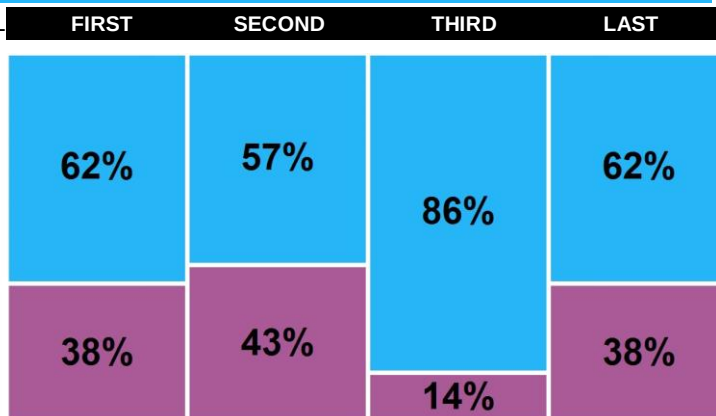

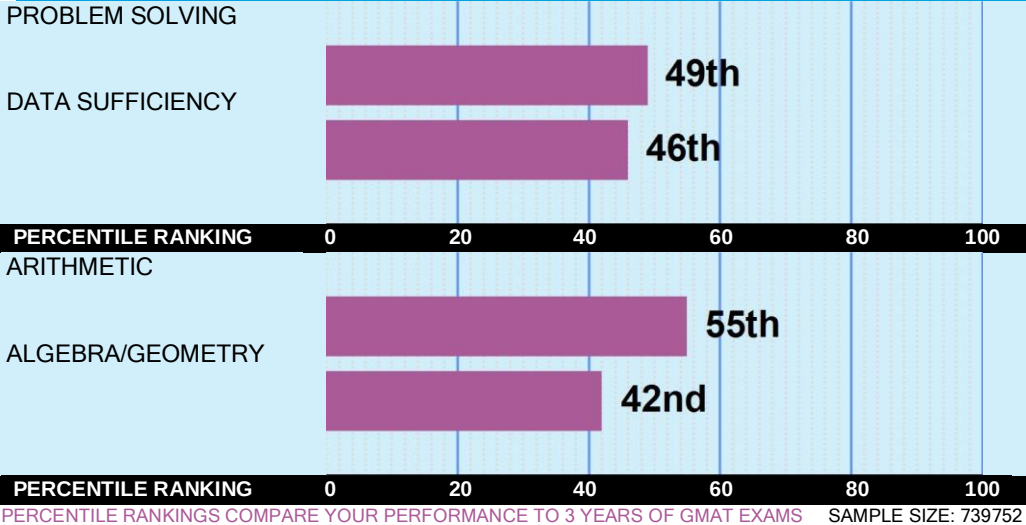

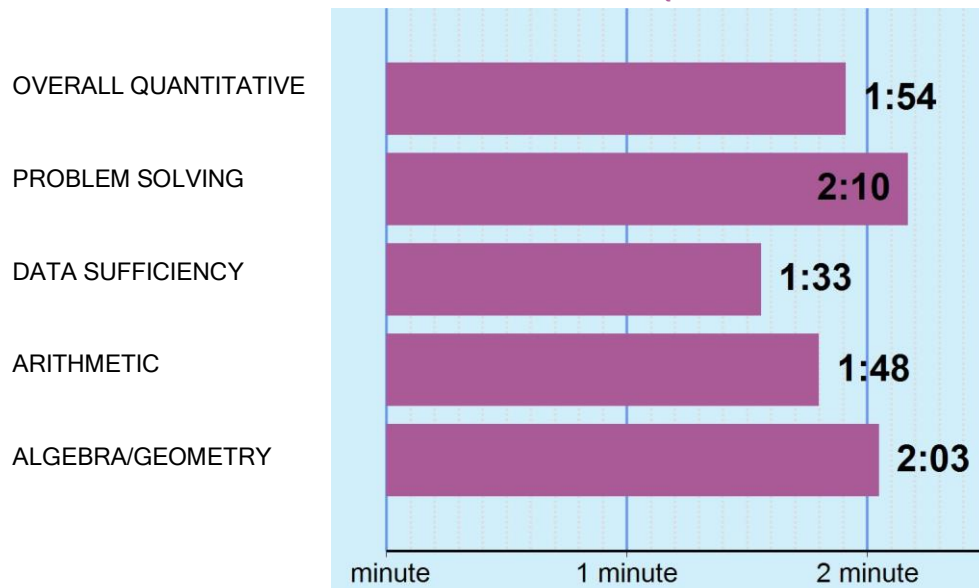

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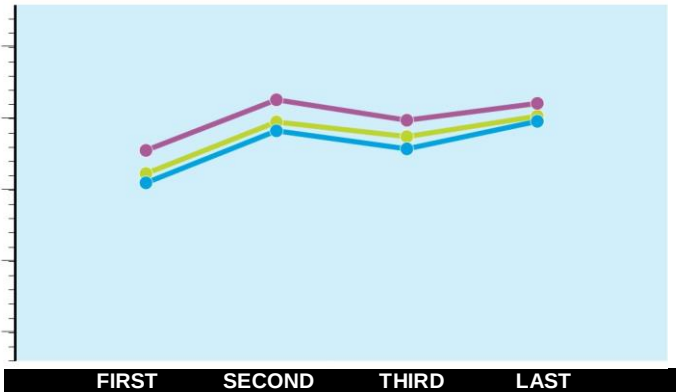

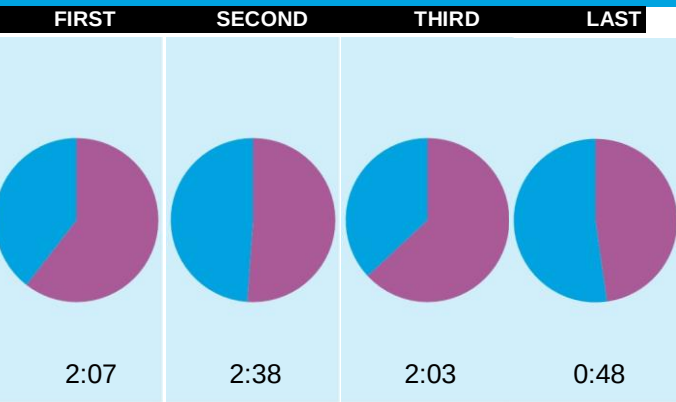
