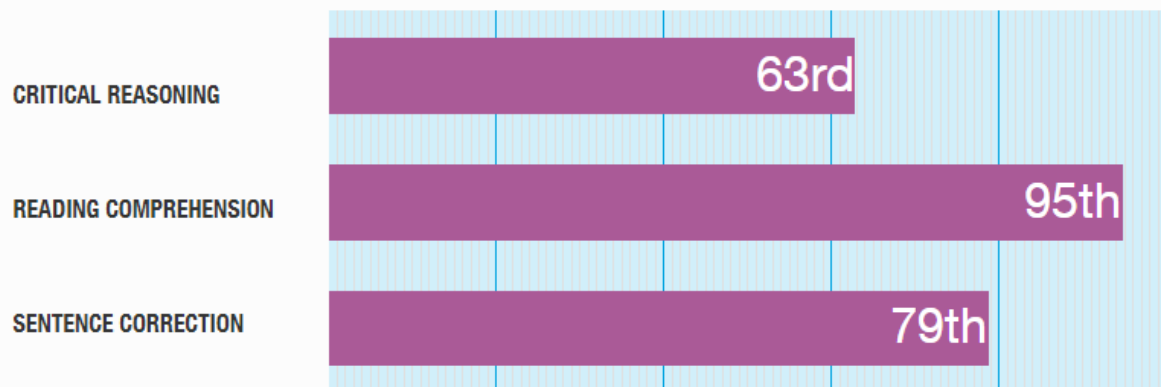

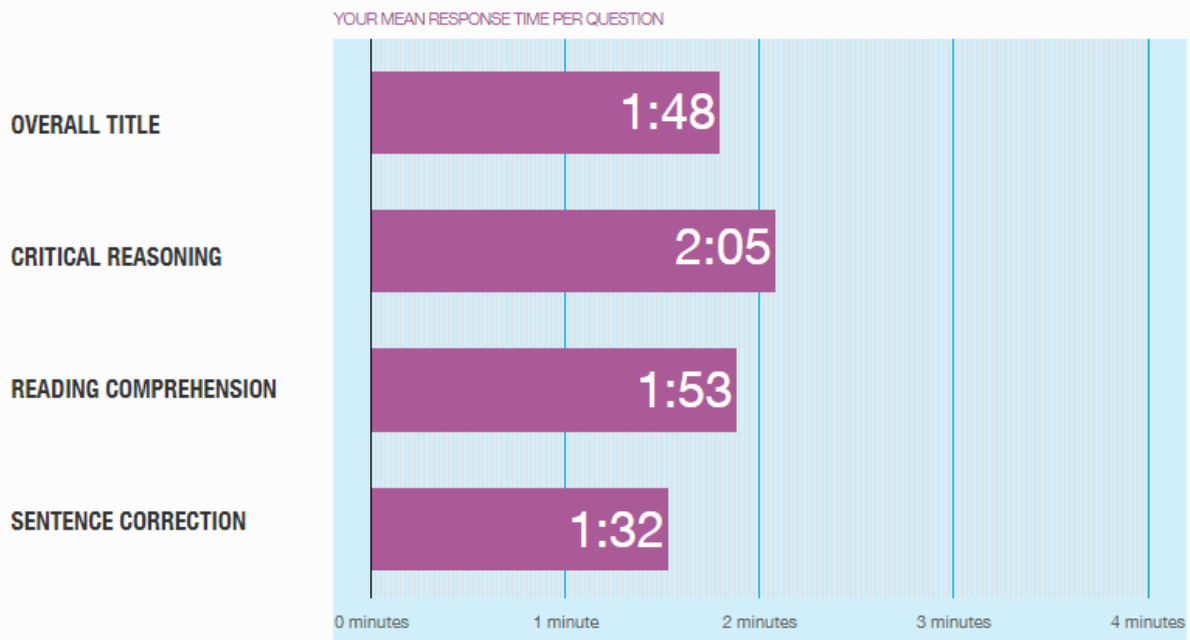

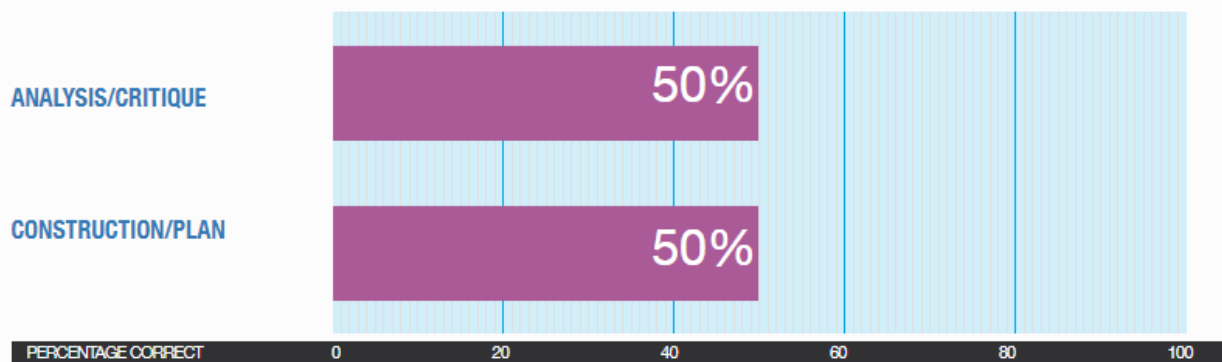

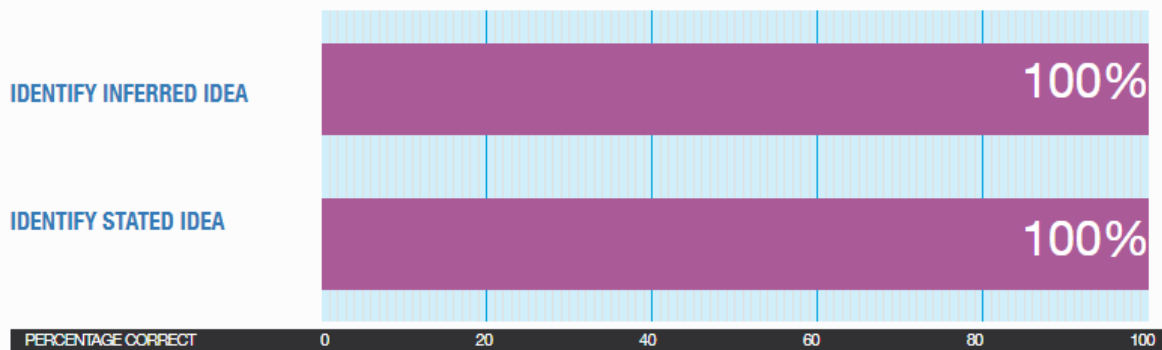


PERFORMANCE BY FUNDAMENTAL SKILLS

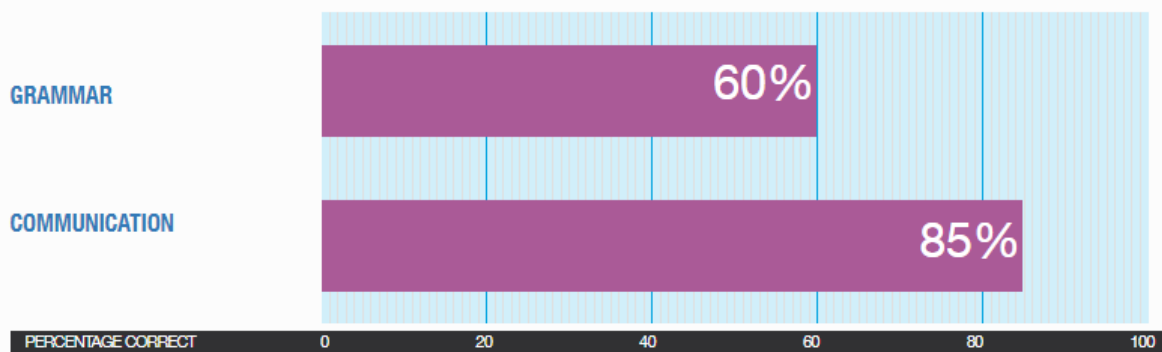

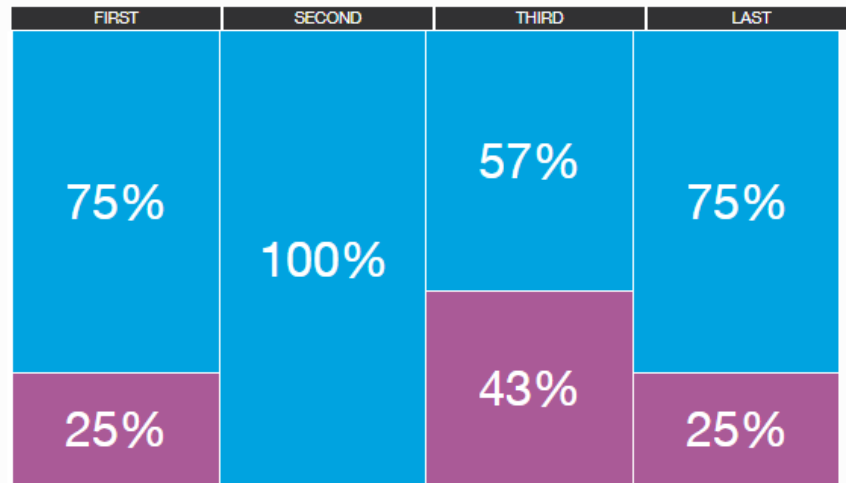


PERFORMANCE PROGRESSION

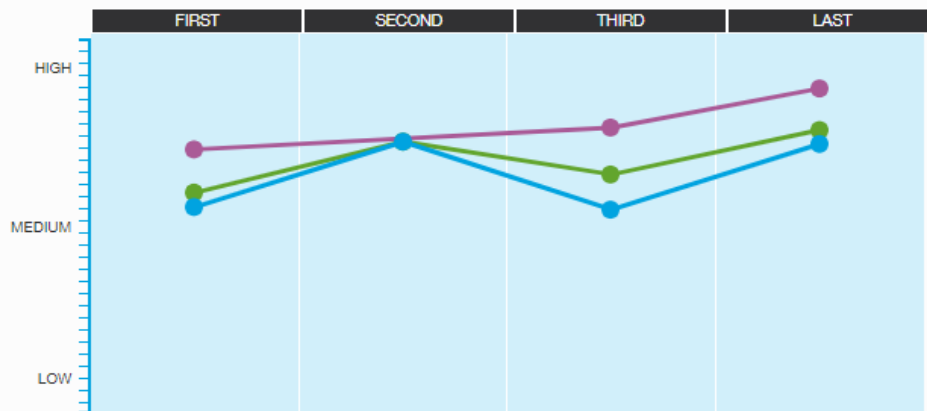

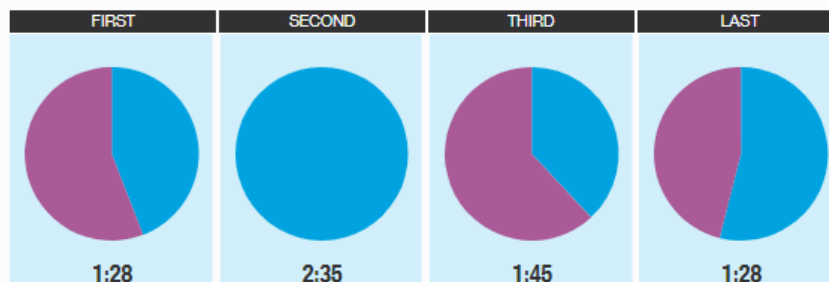


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TIME MANAGEMENT

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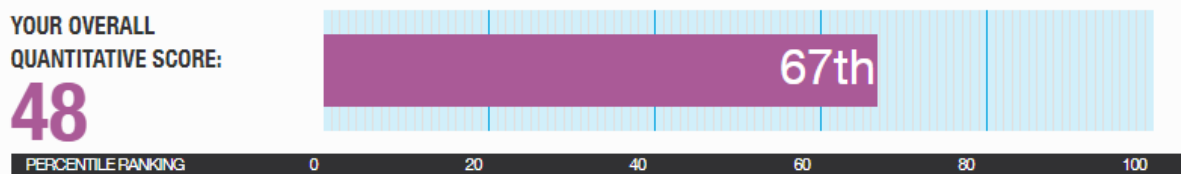
SUMMARY

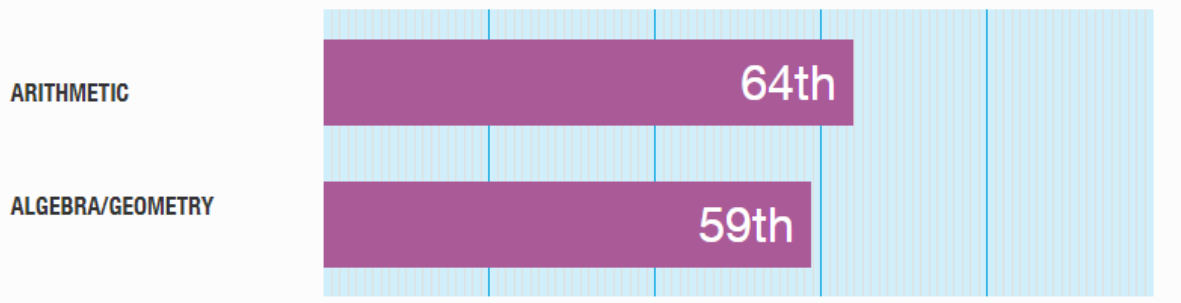

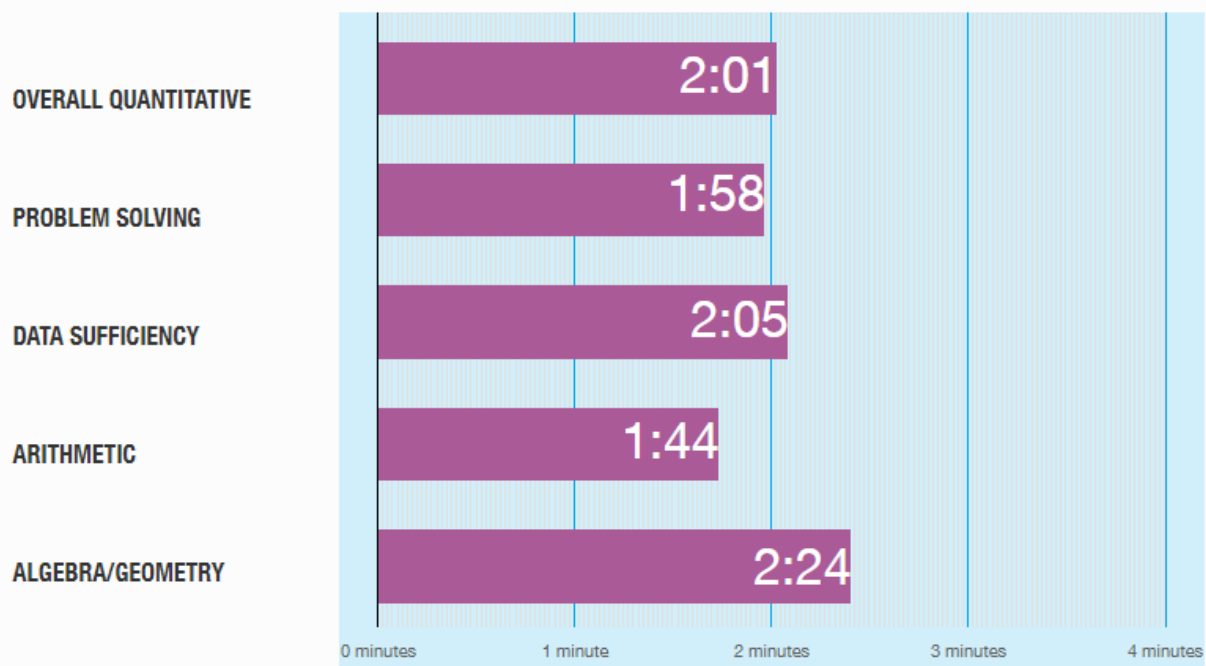

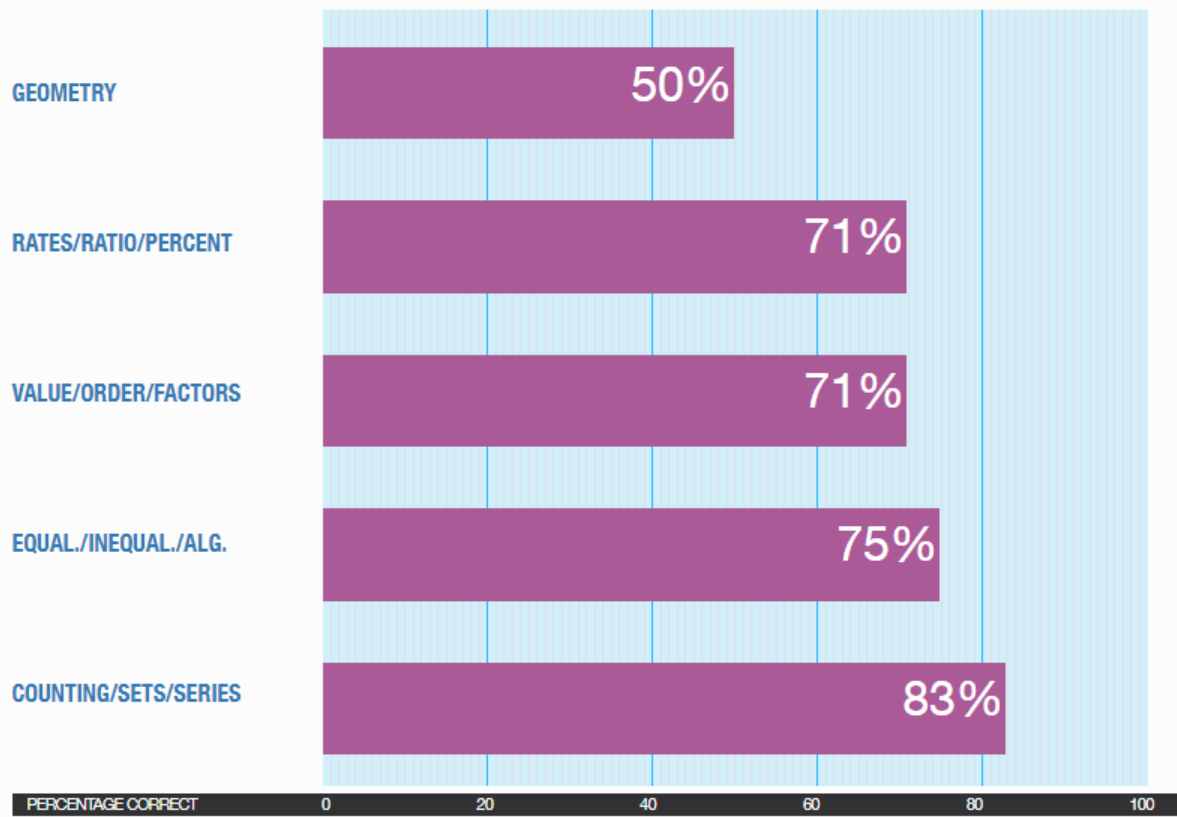


SUB-SECTION TIME MANAGEMENT

PERFORMANCE BY FUNDAMENTAL SKILLS

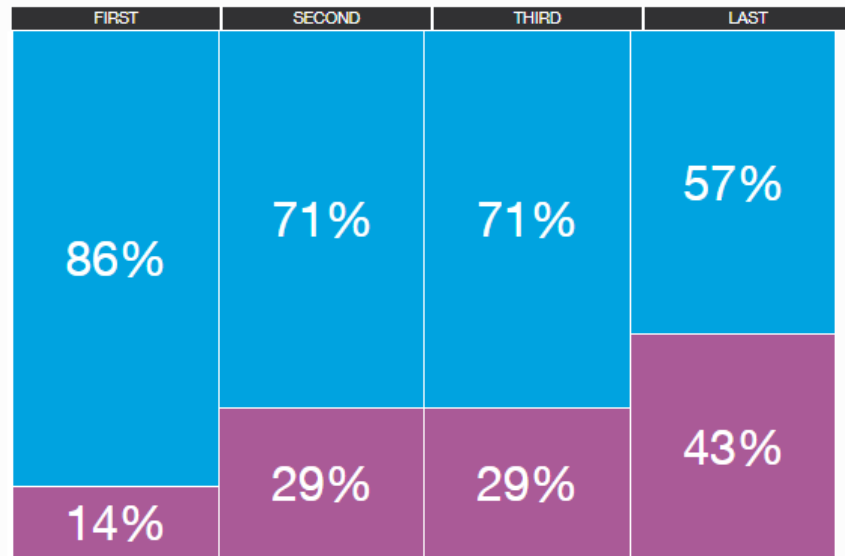

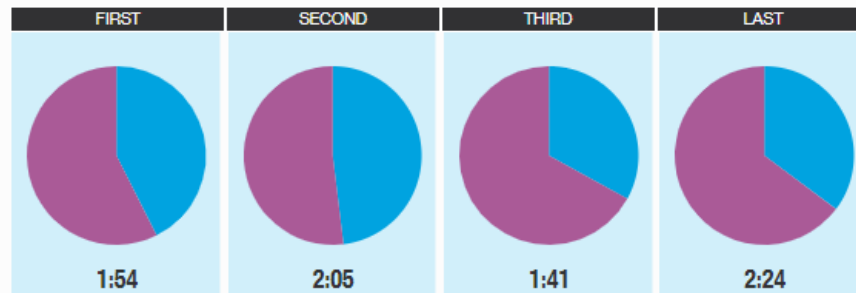


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TIME MANAGEMENT
