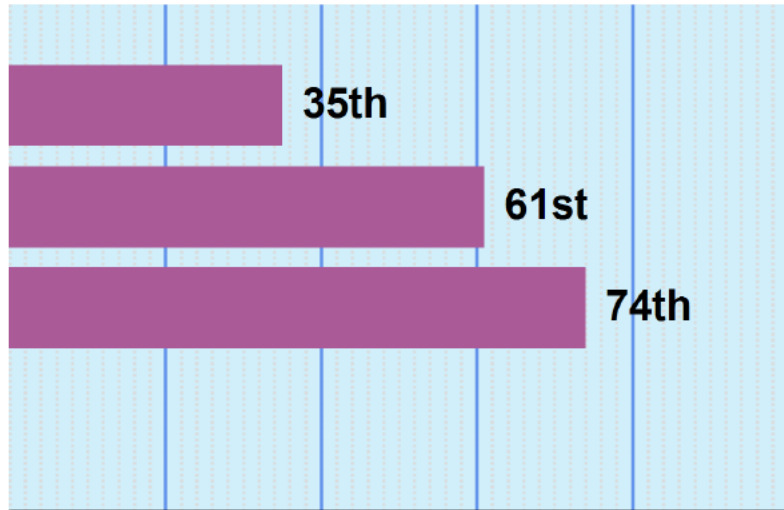

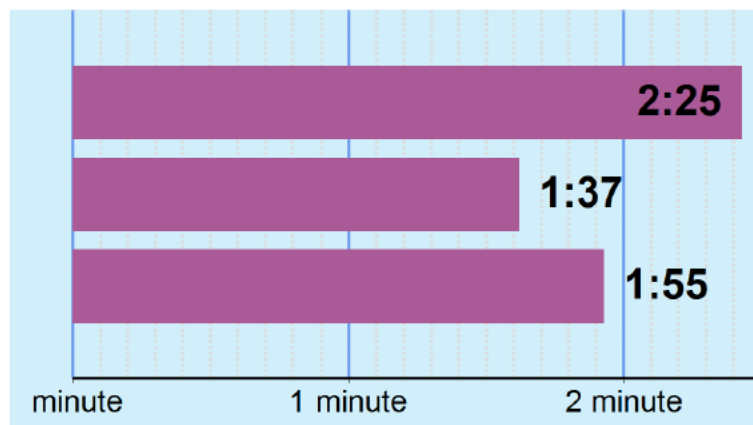

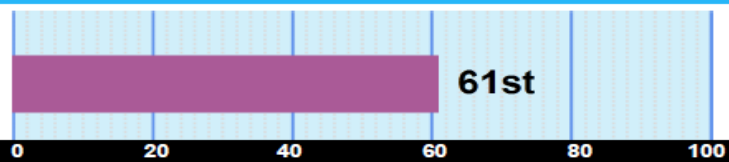

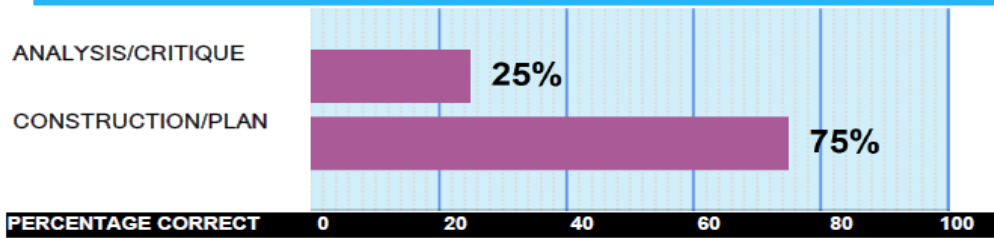

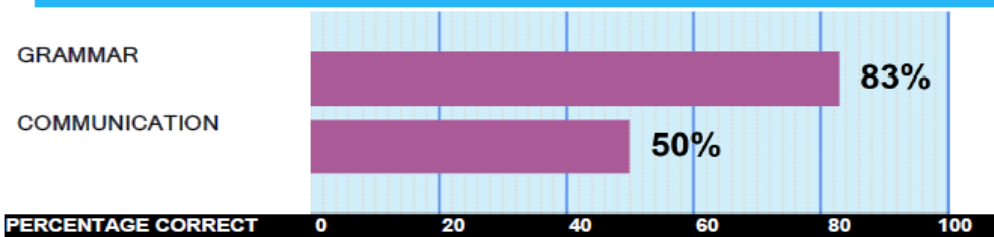

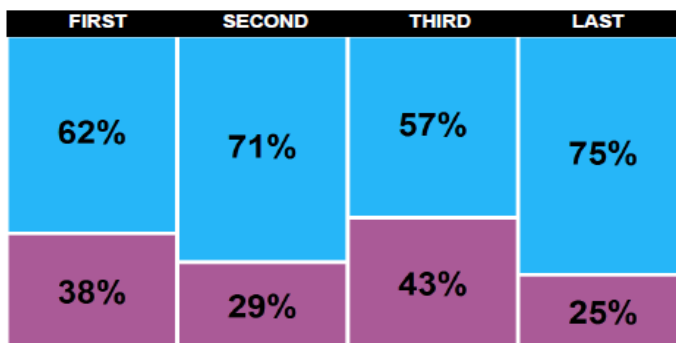

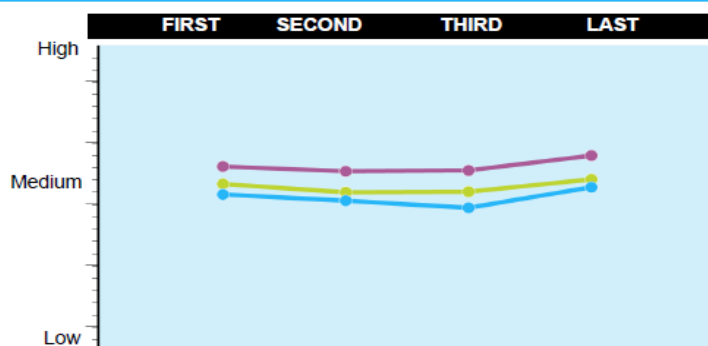

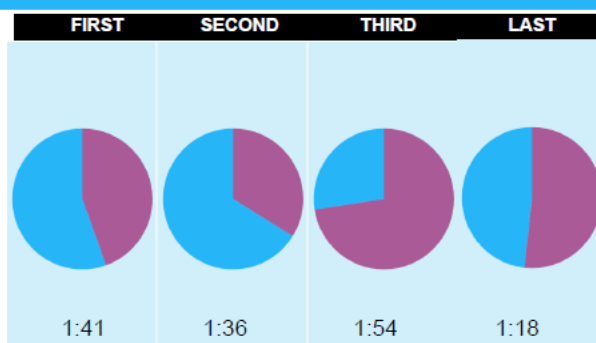

SUMMARY

- Your Verbal score of 31 is higher than 61% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this section is 27.08.
- Your performance on Critical Reasoning questions was equivalent to a score of 27, which is better than 45% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this sub-section is 27.57.
 - Your performance of 25% on Analysis/Critique questions is considered Very Weak.
 - Your performance of 75% on Construction/Plan questions is considered Above Average.
