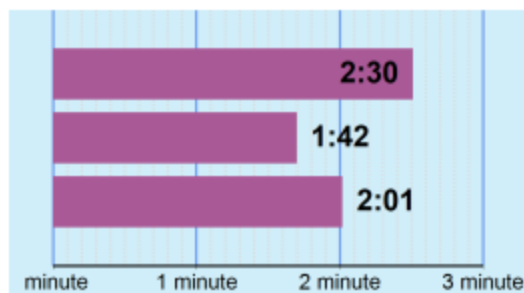

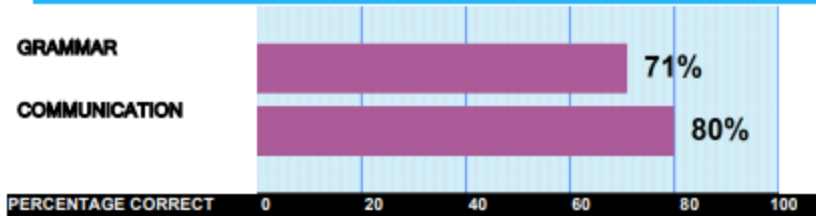

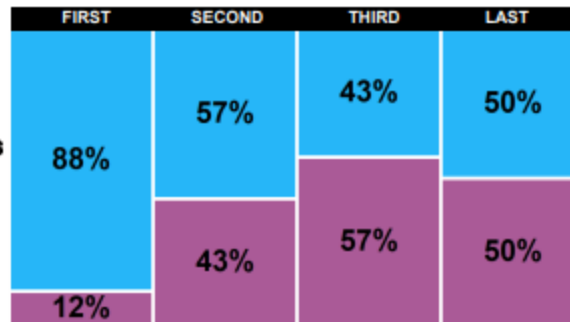

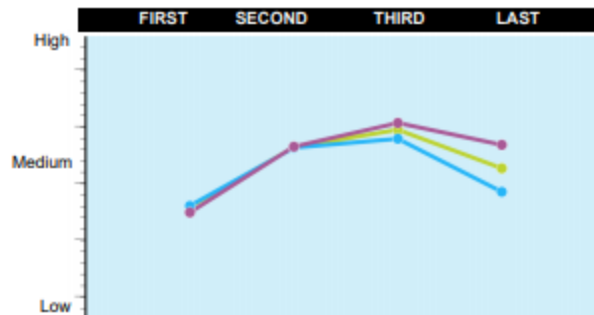

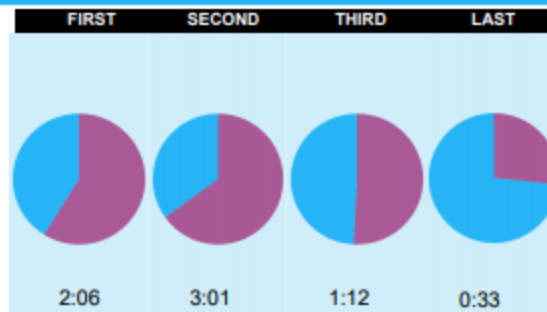

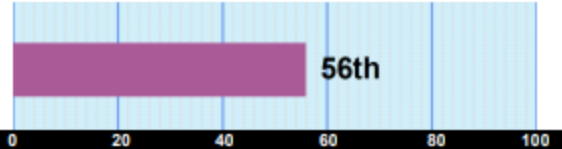

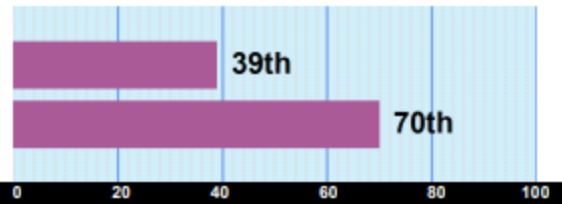

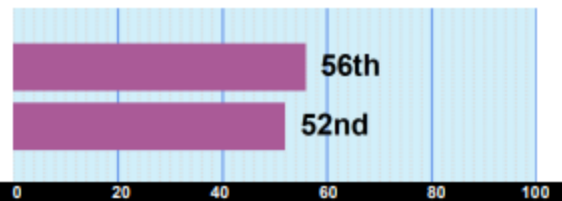

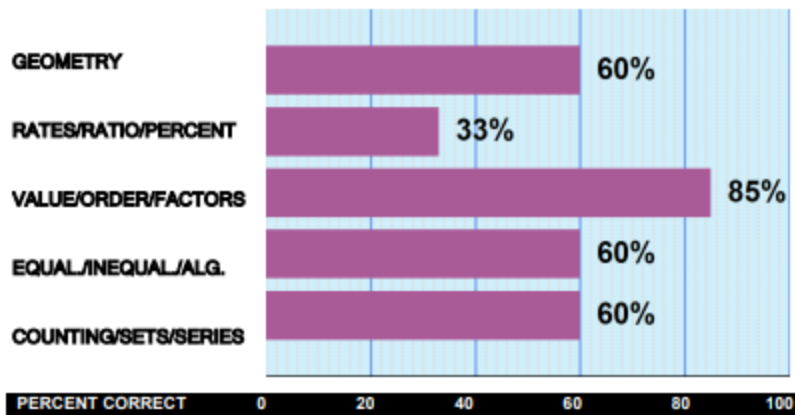

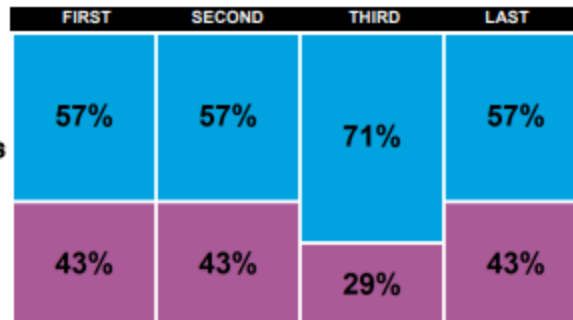

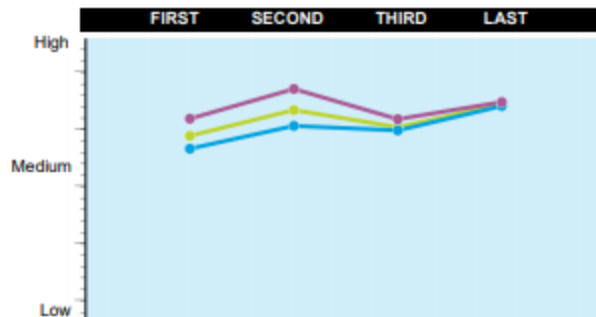

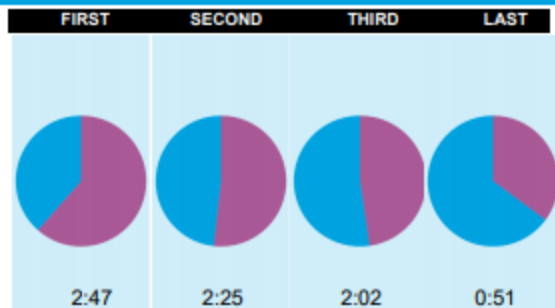

SUMMARY

- Your Quantitative score of 46 is higher than 56% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this section is 40.38.
