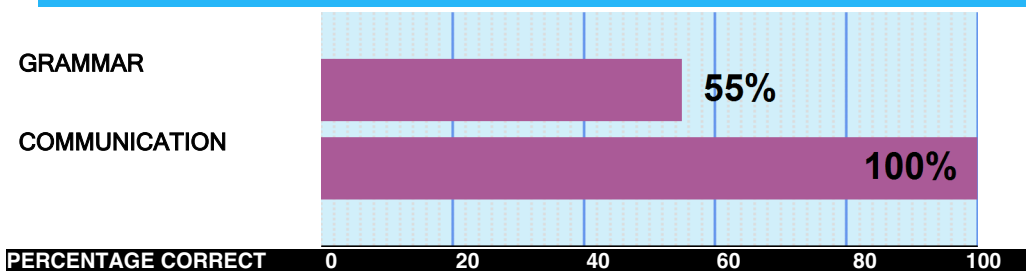

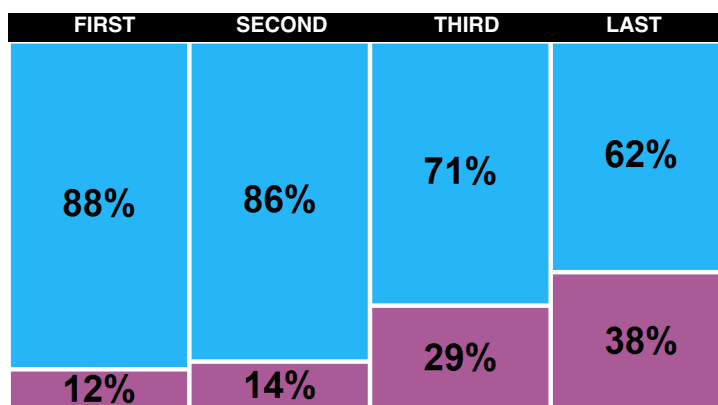

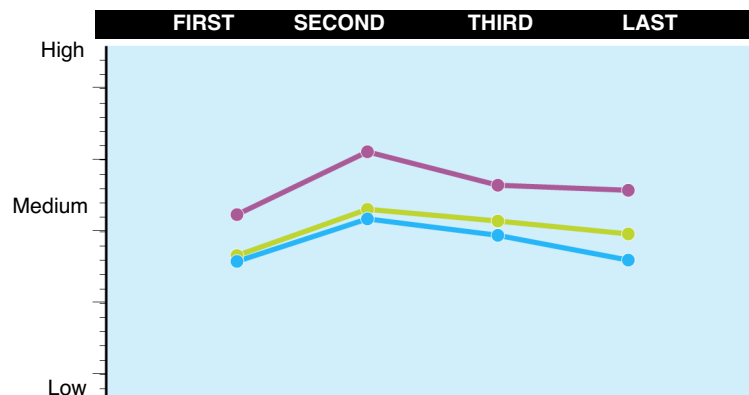

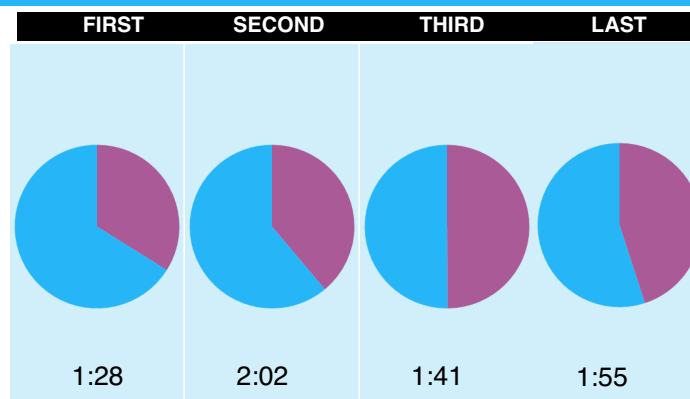

SUMMARY

- Your Verbal score of 32 is higher than 64% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this section is 27.51.
- Your performance on Critical Reasoning questions was equivalent to a score of 44, which is better than 94% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years. The mean score for this sub-section is 27.97.
