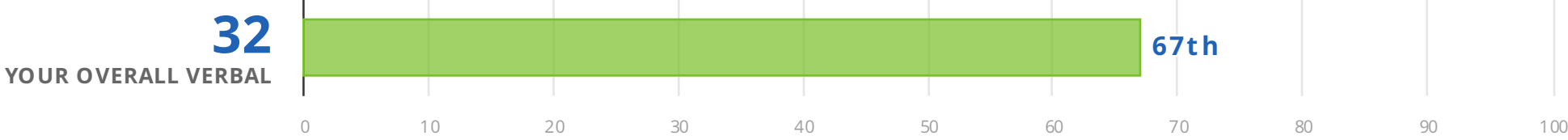

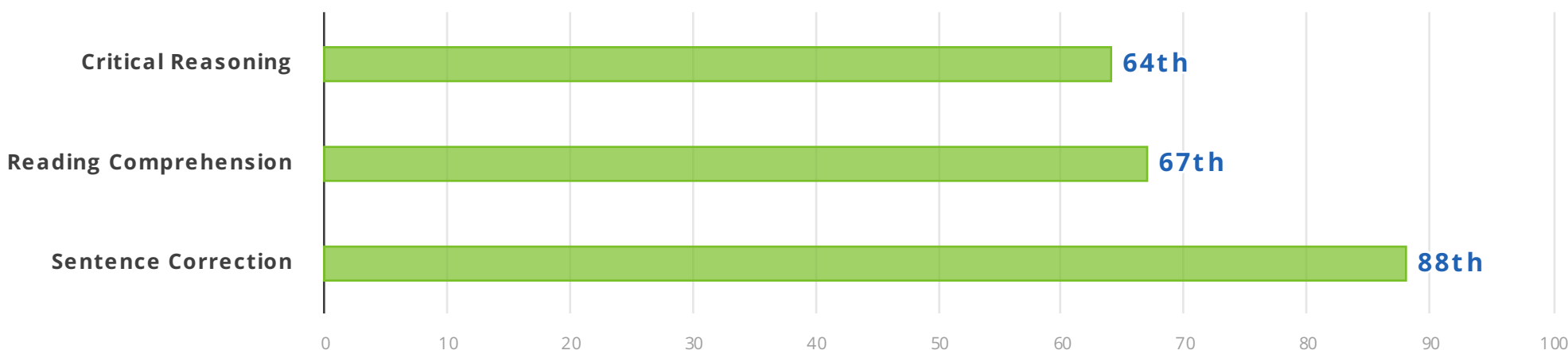

Definition

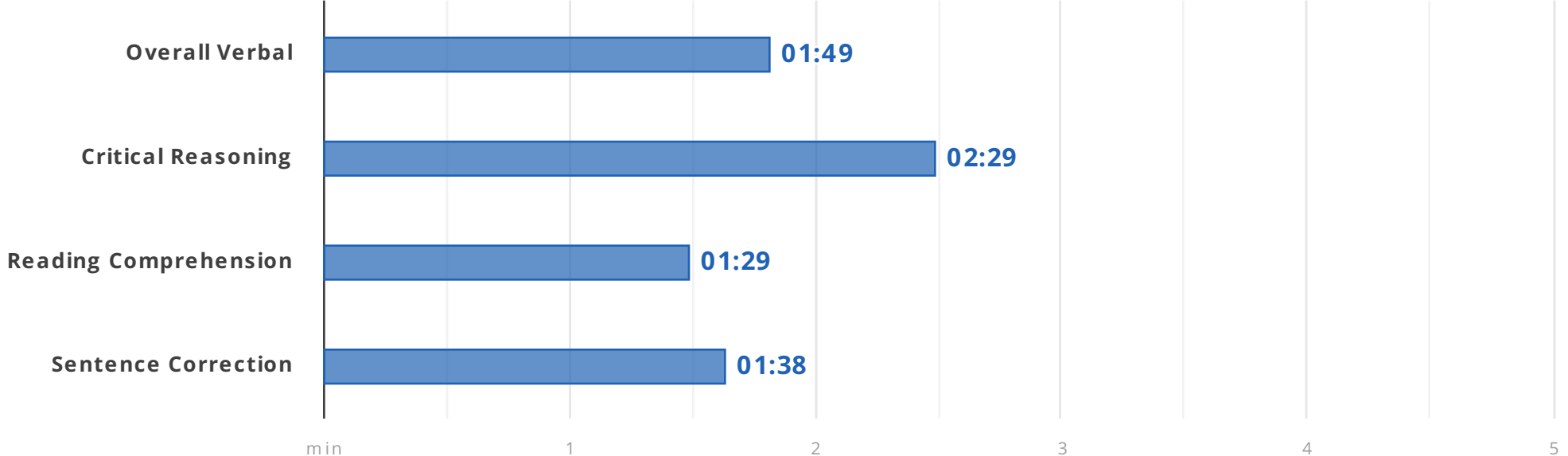
The three year mean GMAT Verbal score is 27.51. This score is better than 44% of GMAT Exam scores recorded in the past three years.

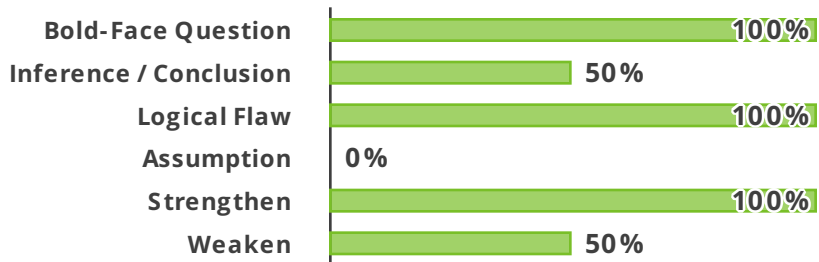

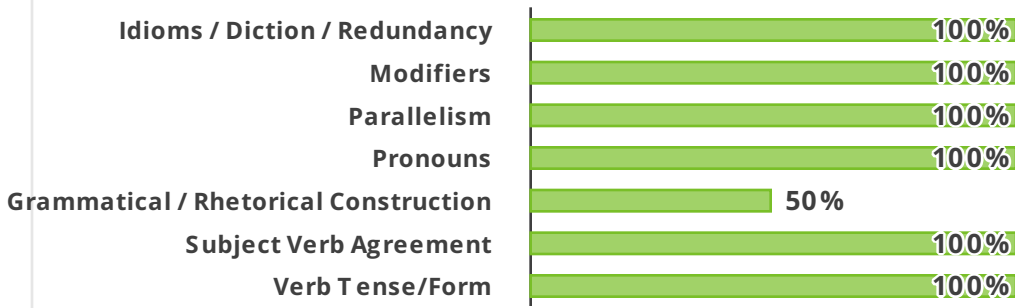

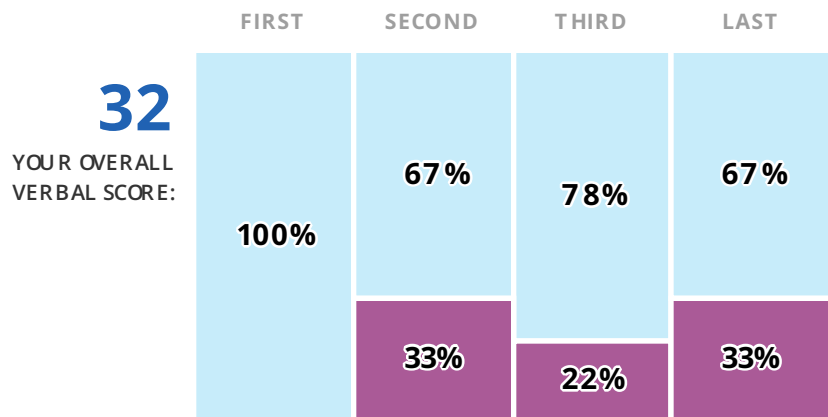

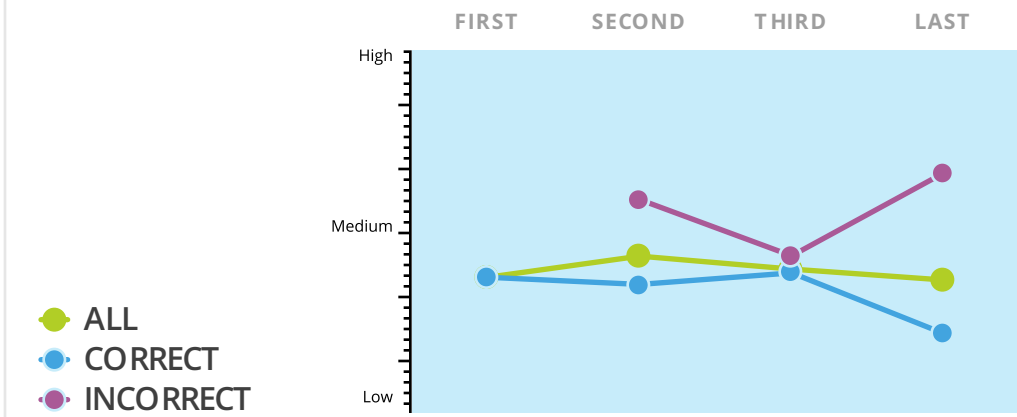
Percent Correct

"Each section in this graph represents approximately one quarter of the questions in order of presentation."

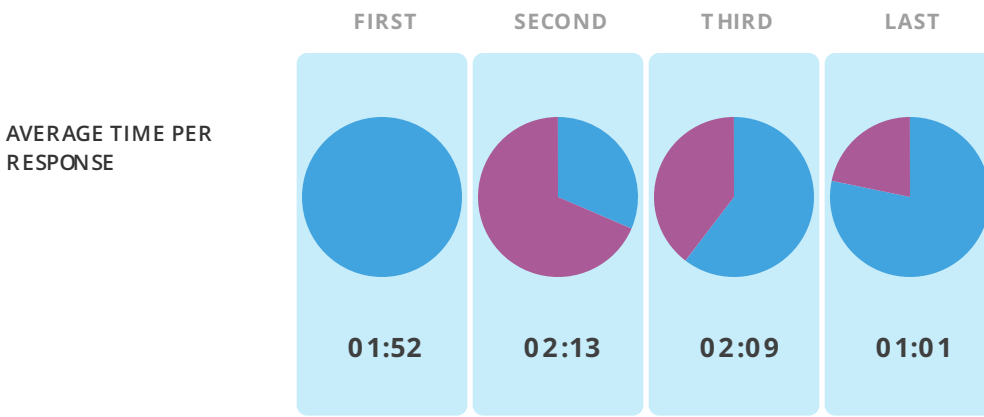
Average Difficulty

SUMMARY
